

Story of a Young Child Who Lost Both Parents in the Persecution

Six-year-old Huang Xinyu was orphaned and now lives with her grandparents



Huang Xinyu was born on January 8, 1998. She is in first grade at Guangming Elementary School, Wanghua District, Fushun City. Her parents, both Falun Gong practitioners, died as a result of the persecution. She is now living with the paternal grandparents.

When Huang Xinyu's mother Zhong Yunxiu died, Xinyu was less than 2 years old. On September 29, 1999, Xinyu's mother died at 27 years of age as a result of the persecution. She was an English teacher at Beisanjia Middle School in Qingyuan County in Fushun City, Liaoning Province. On July 20, 1999, she went to appeal on behalf of Falun Gong in Beijing and in late September, she was illegally arrested. On September 29, 1999, while being taken back to her home province, Xinyu's mother jumped from a speeding train in order to escape from illegal detention and died.

Huang Xinyu was 5 years old when her father Huang Ke was tortured to death. Huang Ke used to work in the No.10 Research Branch in Fushun Petroleum Chemical Industry Research Institute. After his wife Zhong Yunxiu died, Huang's work unit refused to let him return to work. On July 3, 2003, Huang Ke was tortured to death in the No. 1 Detention Center of Fushun City when he was 31 years old.

The grandparents of little Huang Xinyu have a difficult life. Due to an accident, her grandmother suffers from a mental disorder. Xinyu's father Huang Ke worked at the same work unit as his father Huang Zuhai, where people were deceived by anti-Falun Gong propaganda. As a result, Huang Ke's father has had to bear a lot of rumors and slanderous comments from his colleagues. Little Xinyu is one of the children who lost her parents in this terrible persecution.

Rescuing Falun Gong Children in China

We can only imagine how many children are suffering from the loss of their parents and who are enduring hardships because their parents were imprisoned or sent to labour camps. But what is even more shocking is that young children are being directly targeted for persecution by Jiang's followers simply because their parents practice Falun Gong. Over the past six years, countless children have suffered from prejudice, intimidation, illegal detention, beatings and homelessness. Some have even been tortured to death. The harm done to these children is impossible to calculate. The suffering of children that is documented is just a drop in the ocean compared to what has taken place over the past six years of persecution.

Global Mission to Rescue Persecuted Falun Gong Practitioners

Several constituent groups have united to form an international non-profit human rights organization (the GMR Global Mission to Rescue persecuted Falun Gong practitioners), including family members and friends of persecuted Falun Gong practitioners, as well as people and organizations that are concerned about the human rights violations against Falun Gong practitioners in China. The Mission of GMR is to rescue out of China children who have been orphaned as a result of the persecution, and establish a boarding school in North America to ensure a nurturing environment and good education for these children.
